Understanding LGBTQ+ Law in Florida - 6/15

Join us on Sat., 6/15 in Killeen Hall, 10 AM- 12 PM, for this Integrity Tallahassee event, where David Grimes will give an introductory overview of legal issues impacting lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer Floridians, and those who interact with them. The overview will include brief review of LGBTQ+ history, a real-world exploration of why we care about LGBTQ+ issues and bias elimination, a survey of the emergence of constitutional law regarding LGBTQ+ individuals, and an exploration of federal and state developments with a focus on legislative and executive decisions.
